Good to catch up this morning.

I promised to follow up a couple of things –

1. The information [redacted] pulled together for [redacted] in response to questions about predator control and predator control methods – See attached email chain.
2. An outline / the preparation for the Gylfinir Cymru meeting next week – I have spoken to [redacted]. [redacted] is preparing a short brief for the meeting to discuss some principles - e.g. 1. curlew is in declines, 2. driver is poor breeding success, 3. what is this caused by - hay cutting times and predation. If so does the partnership agree that predator control is needed as one of the conservation interventions? Principles will be based on discussions with expert advisors - [redacted]. The item is definitely about discussing the principles on whether predator control is needed for curlew conservation. NOT the method. [redacted] is aware of the risk's and saw first-hand when [redacted] used the site mtg for Gylfinir Cymru as a vehicle for promoting the use of snares with the Minister. [redacted] is off today but [redacted] will circulate the draft brief to you and I today for a review before it goes to the wider group.
3. The HoT issues we did for the BoCC Wales publication with details about the General Licences – Attached.
