Thank you for your request which was received on 19 September 2023. You asked for the following information:

- *A list of public projects in Wales that have been financed by the Private Finance Initiative (PFI)?*
- *How much is each individual project costing?*

The list of public projects in Wales that have been financed by PFI is reported annually as part of the HM Treasury annual reporting of Private Finance Initiative and Private Finance 2 projects.
