Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 27 March. You asked for:

- 1. How much of the £100k allocated to the Community Radio Fund in 2012/13 was awarded, the names of the 8 stations supported and the amount each was awarded.
- 2. The total amount awarded from the Welsh Government Community Radio Fund (from 2008/09 to 2012/13).

Our response

 I can confirm that £100,000 was awarded from the Community Radio Fund during 2012/13. The names of the stations and the amounts awarded are included below:

2. I can confirm that the total amount awarded from the Welsh Government Community Radio Fund between 2008/09 and 2012/13 was £467,518 as you noted in your correspondence.

For your information, in early 2013, the Welsh Government decided to extend the Community Radio Fund for a further year beyond its original time limit of five years. This extension period gave community radio stations an opportunity to investigate alternative sources of funding and to prepare to become self-sufficient post March 2014. The names of the stations and the amounts awarded are included below:

Therefore, a total of £567,518 was awarded from the Community Radio Fund between 2008/09 and 2013/14.
