*Herds in the Low Risk Area (LRA) of England do not need to premovement test (PrMT), unless they are on an annual or more frequent herd testing frequency when any of the following applies:

- post-breakdown herds (herds with 6M and 12M testing work schedules)
- re-formed herds where depopulation was for TB control purposes
- herds within potential new hotspot areas
- herds contiguous to herds with their Officially Tuberculosis Free status withdrawn
- herds subject to a radial testing regime
- herds considered to be at high risk due to the nature of the enterprise and therefore subject to a more frequent HTI (UMR)
- all herds registered as temporary CPHs (tCPHs) in the Low Risk Area (LRA) if associated with a pCPH in the High Risk Area (HRA) or Edge Area
- those pCPHs within the LRA if associated with a tCPH in the HRA or Edge Area and if the testing frequency is increased to annually (or six monthly)
- all herds registered to tCPHs in the LRA associated to the permanent CPH of an annually testing herd in the LRA
- dealers' herds
- heifer rearing herds
- bull hiring herds
- Al studs

- in any other case at the Veterinary Head of Field Delivery (VHoFD)/Veterinary Lead Scotland (VLS) discretion
- When cattle are moving to Scotland

**Northern Ireland export certification requirements -

The PrMT requirements depend on whether the cattle are for breeding, production or slaughter and whether they are coming direct from a premises of origin, or market, or from an assembly centre via a GB export premises, or an export assembly centre.

*** A post import test is required for all cattle moves from Northern Ireland to Wales

Imported cattle from Northern Ireland must be TB tested 60 days after their arrival in Wales. For disease control reasons, testing must be carried out as close to the start of the testing window as possible and as soon as possible after 60 days post-import and in all cases before 120 days have elapsed.

Cattle imported directly from Northern Ireland to the Low TB Area of Wales and imported or to the Intermediate TB Areas of Wales are required to remain on the destination holding and have a post-movement test between 60 and 120 days after import. The post-import check test (PII) can act as the post-movement test.

**** Pre-movement test results are only valid for 30 days for moves to Scotland.
