Complaint in respect of ATISN 19561 – WG representative

Thank you for your complaint received on 29 May 2024 in respect of our response dated 29 May 2024 to your Freedom of Information request reference ATISN 19561 - WG representative.

You have requested of a review of our decision to withhold the full name of the WG representative who attended a Wales Interpretation and Translation Service (WITS) Advisory Board meeting on 27 September 2023.

It was determined that, at the time of your request on 13 May 2024, the full name of the WG representative was exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act and it was therefore withheld.

I have reviewed the facts and circumstances at the point of your request and consider that the exemption was applied correctly at that time.

Therefore, I uphold the original decision to withhold the full name of the Welsh Government representative as it complied with our obligations under the Freedom of Information Act and data protection principles of the GDPR at the time your request was submitted.
