Specifically asking what funding and/or services have been cut and if we plan to make cuts to resources to support the provision of community rehabilitation in the next 12 months.

Provision, delivery and planning of community rehabilitation services are the responsibility of integrated health boards who work with a variety of stakeholders to deliver local services.
