Seeking clarification on maternity correspondence

We are in regular contact about the maternity and neonatal services as of the enhanced monitoring arrangements and we regularly discuss issues of concern about the service.

We did discuss on the 25 April 2024 and 02 May 2024 the article that was published <u>online</u> on 23 April 2024, and you gave us reassurances that the service was safe and that the issues raised in the article had been satisfactorily resolved. Since the publication of this article, Wesh Government has received several pieces of correspondence regarding it.

Following up on the conversations we had on we would seek more detail on a number of areas pertaining to the correspondence.

- Are you able to provide details of the maternal death you believe the article refers to including any contributory factors identified from subsequent reviews?
- Can you provide further details on the closure of the ITU area within maternity including why and how this decision was reached and what provisions do you now have in place?
