- 2. Where (by road name) each recorded incident took place broken down my month year and type of animal.

We hold some information for questions 1-2. We do not hold the information by month.

Information for 1 January 2022 to 30 April 2023 has been released under a previous Fol request Fol 17458 and can be found on the Welsh Government website. <u>Home</u> <u>GOV.WALES</u>. For ease I am attaching the spreadsheet.

For information for 1 May 2023 to 30 June 2024 please see the second attached spreadsheet.

The information is taken from two record sets, so it is possible there is duplication of information. These figures are taken from reports received of a dead animal so should not be taken to be the full extent of dead animals on our network.
