I wrote to you on 16 July regarding your request for information.

Information requested

1. The names of companies that been approached about completing the work?
2. Copies of the plans for works to be undertaken?
3. The responsible Welsh Government Minister?
4. Copies of advice provided to the Minister regarding the situation of SA1?
5. Copies of the Ministers response to the advice.
6. The expected date for work to commence?

Our response

I can confirm that replies to your questions are as follows:-

1. WG have appointed HR Wallingford and Shoreline Management Wales to carry out a feasibility review of possible design options to reinstate the revetment so that the footpath can reopen. No approaches to companies have been made about completing the work.
2. Copies of the plans for the reinstatement works are not yet available as the feasibility work is ongoing.
3. The Cabinet Secretary for the Economy, Transport and North Wales.

6. Until the review of the feasibility, a design cannot be selected and hence it is not possible to determine the expected date for works to commence.
