

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A483  
(CROESFAN REILFFORDD FFAIR-FACH,  
FFAIR-FACH, SIR GAERFYRDDIN)  
(GWAHARDD CERBYDAU DROS DRO) 2024**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A483, neu gerllaw iddi, wrth groesfan reilffordd Ffair-fach, Ffair-fach, Sir Gaerfyrdin.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd, ac eithrio'r rhai a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau brys ac ar gyfer y gwaith, rhag mynd ar y darn o gefnffordd yr A483 a elwir Heol Cennen, Ffair-fach sy'n ymestyn am 20 metr y naill ochr a'r llall i'r groesfan reilffordd.

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer cerbydau sy'n teithio tua'r gogledd yw mynd tua'r de ar yr A483 i Gylchfan Pont Abraham, mynd tua'r gogledd ar yr A48 i Gylchfan Cross Hands a mynd tua'r gogledd-ddwyrain ar yr A476 i ailymuno â'r A483 i'r gogledd o'r groesfan reilffordd yn Ffair-fach: i'r gwrt hwyneb ar gyfer cerbydau sy'n teithio tua'r de.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 19 Medi 2024. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaharddiad dros dro yn weithredol o 23:30 o'r gloch ar 19 Medi hyd 05:00 o'r gloch ar 20 Medi 2024, neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y dyddiadau a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn dechrau unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (FFAIRFACH LEVEL CROSSING, FFAIRFACH, CARMARTHENSHIRE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER 2024**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A483 trunk road at Ffairfach level crossing, Ffairfach, Carmarthenshire.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all vehicles, other than those being used by the emergency services and for the works, from proceeding on the length of the A483 trunk road known as Heol Cennen, Ffairfach that extends for 20 metres either side of the level crossing.

The alternative route for northbound vehicles is via the southbound A483 to Pont Abraham Roundabout, northbound A48 to Cross Hands Roundabout and north-eastbound A476 to re-join the A483 to the north of the level crossing at Ffairfach: vice versa for southbound vehicles.

The Order comes into force on 19 September 2024. The temporary prohibition is expected to operate from 23:30 hours on 19 September until 05:00 hours on 20 September 2024, or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the dates specified above it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work begins.
