Information requested

You asked for the following information:

Can you advise if any properties or areas of land within the Local Authority are affected by a **live** Compulsory Purchase Order? If so, can you provide a list/map of the affected areas.

Our response

As you sent the same request to Merthyr Tydfil County Borough Council (MTCBC), I have taken your request to be for Compulsory Purchase Orders (CPOs) in MTCBC area only.

I can confirm the Welsh Government does hold information on CPOs for which we are responsible. However, as I advised in response to your previous request ATISN 19540 on 20 May 2024, FOI release 19540: Compulsory Purchase Order | GOV.WALES CPOs are in the public domain, so I have concluded that it is exempt from disclosure under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, information otherwise available. The information is available at and can be found on the Welsh Government website Roads and driving | Sub-topic | GOV.WALES and the CPOs will be within the Current Road Improvement Projects and then the relevant project, in this instance the A465: Section 5&6 Dowlais Top to Hirwaun.
