Play Sufficiency Assessment Working Group - Information Audit

This is an audit tool to assist Play Monitoring Group (or equivalent) members during the preparation stage in identifying and collating information relating to each theme when considering each of the Matters.

Theme	Where the information may be held	Contact person	Date information gathered / to be gathered
<p>Population</p> <p>This theme relates to:</p> <p>Matter A: the number of children in respect of each age range within its area.</p> <p>Matter B: the needs of children from different cultures and backgrounds within its area.</p> <p>Matter E: whether there is a charge for play provision and where there is a charge.</p>			

<p>Places where children play</p> <p>This theme relates to:</p> <p>Matter C: the space where children can play, including open space, and any other space.</p> <p>Matter F: the traffic measures that are used to promote access to play.</p> <p>Matter I: the extent to which education take into account the need to enhance play opportunities for children.</p>			
<p>Supervised provision</p> <p>This theme relates to:</p> <p>Matter D: supervised play provision.</p> <p>Matter G: playwork training and workforce development.</p>			

<p>Policy synergy, engagement, advocacy and information</p> <p>This theme relates to:</p> <p>Matter F: measures that are used to promote access to play, including the advertisement of play provision and any play events.</p> <p>Matter G: training opportunities for the play work force.</p> <p>Matter H: the level of community engagement and participation.</p> <p>Matter I: the extent to which other policies of a local authority take into account the need to enhance play opportunities for children.</p>			
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
