# 1. National Resident Survey - Case Study Published

In July 2024, we went live with our National Resident Survey offer. This included a standardised survey that local councils run with their residents, as well as a results dashboard to support national comparison and benchmarking.

# 2. Regional Learning and Skills Partnerships – Labour Market Data Procured

We provide data support to the four regional skills partnerships across Wales. We procure labour market data on their behalf, reducing costs through collaboration. In November, we extended this support by procuring a commercial labour market tool that allows the user to generate their own economic classifications, not limiting them to the traditional SIC/SOC categorisations. This tool should be more adept at classifying and capturing data about emerging sectors, such as FinTech, which aren't well accommodated in the traditional economic classification systems.
