



National Survey for Wales: Cognitive testing of 2022-23 questions

Executive summary

1. Introduction and methodology

Background

- 1.1 The National Survey for Wales is a continuous survey involving around 12,000 randomly selected respondents aged 16 and over across Wales each year. The survey covers a wide range of topics including public services, employment, childcare, the Welsh language, and health and social care services. Topics are reviewed each year to ensure the survey continues to meet the needs of survey users.
- 1.2 Previously the survey was carried out face-to-face in respondents' homes, but due to the Covid-19 pandemic it has been carried out as a telephone survey since May 2020. The survey is expected to be carried out by telephone until at least March 2023.
- 1.3 The aim of this research project was to cognitively test a range of new questions developed for the National Survey for 2022-23. It is vital to use pre-testing methods, such as cognitive testing, to assess survey questions and to ensure that the questions and response options are clear and understood in a consistent manner by respondents with diverse characteristics, and that respondents are willing and able to answer the questions. This helps to ensure that the survey questions are reliable, valid, unbiased and sensitive.

Methodology – desk review

- 1.4 To evaluate the new questions developed for the National Survey for Wales for 2022-23, NatCen Social Research was commissioned by Welsh Government to carry out a desk review and two rounds of cognitive testing interviews. The desk review of potential new questions was carried out by researchers in NatCen's Questionnaire Development and Testing Hub, who are experts in questionnaire design and cognitive interviewing. For this review, a revised version of the Questionnaire Appraisal System (QAS-99) was used. The QAS-99 is a checklist which can be used to systematically review survey questions for problems in the wording or structure of the questions and response options. Two NatCen researchers reviewed the new questions independently of one another, looking at the instructions, wording, layout, routing, respondent burden and suitability for telephone administration.
- 1.5 Based on this review, recommendations were made for questions that were identified as potentially problematic and some of these were flagged as candidates for cognitive testing. A final list of questions for cognitive testing was then agreed with Welsh Government.

Methodology – cognitive testing

- 1.6 In total, thirty cognitive interviews were carried out across two rounds via Zoom video interviews with participants located in Cardiff and Wrexham. The first round of testing aimed to identify any problems with the questions by exploring the respondents' understanding of the questions and response options. The second round retested changes made to questions which were found to be problematic in the first round, and tested a small number of additional questions which were not included in the first round.
- 1.7 Respondents were recruited by a specialist recruitment agency using specifically designed quotas to ensure that all the selected survey questions were relevant to, and therefore tested with, at least two or three respondents.

2. Round one testing

- 2.1 The first round of testing was completed with fifteen participants and included questions on:
- Economic status;
 - Remote working;
 - Childcare;
 - Children's play;
 - Welsh language transmission;
 - Social care;
 - Transport; and
 - Volunteering.
- 2.2 Overall, the cognitive testing findings showed that the selected questions worked well. Respondents were able to understand many questions and easily provide an answer. It was therefore recommended that these questions remain unchanged. For example, the questions on childcare, Welsh language and volunteering worked well and no changes were suggested. These questions were not asked of all participants, so they were included again in the second round to make sure that they were tested with more people.
- 2.3 Problems were identified with some questions in the first round of testing. These were mainly related to understanding of specific terms, incomplete definitions of terms or incomplete question instructions which resulted in uncertainty about how to answer the questions.
- 2.4 Changes and improvements were recommended based on the findings for these questions. It was suggested that the wording of some questions should change slightly; that interviewer instructions be added or changed; and that examples be given where respondents were unsure about how to answer.

3. Round two testing

- 3.1 Some questions were changed in light of the findings from the first round of cognitive testing. The revised questions were tested again in the second round. These included questions on economic status, remote working, children's play and social care.
- 3.2 A small number of additional questions which had not been tested in the first round were also tested. The second round included questions on the following topics:
- Economic status;
 - Remote working;

- Childcare;
- Children's play;
- Welsh language transmission;
- Social care;
- Transport;
- Volunteering; and
- Higher education.

Key findings from round two

- 3.3 The second round of testing showed that most of the revised questions were well understood by the respondents. The clarifications and changes that were applied after the first round of testing helped participants' understanding.
- 3.4 In the second round of testing, problems were identified with some of the additional questions tested, which were similar to the problems described above for the first round of testing. Recommendations included adding explanatory notes to some of the survey questions to help clarify the meaning of certain terms; providing examples; and making minor changes to the wording for questions.
- 3.5 Annex A summarises the questions that were tested in each round. The table highlights the iterative process that each survey question went through during this project. It specifies the original questions proposed by Welsh Government. Following the desk review, some of the questions underwent changes, which were then tested in the first round of cognitive interviews. As discussed above, the questions were then assessed in light of the findings from the cognitive interviews. Again, some of the questions were slightly changed for the second round of interviews. The final column in the table shows the final version of the questions proposed to Welsh Government.
